Clinical Casting

Target Group:

The Course in Clinical Casting is a short course designed to develop the knowledge and skills required for Health Professionals to safely assess the need for and perform this procedure in a variety of settings. It is particularly relevant to Practice Nurses, Emergency Nurses, Community, Regional, Rural & Remote Nurses.

Pre requisites (Minimum requirement):

Registered Nurses (Division 1), Enrolled Nurses (Division 2) and Indigenous Health Care Workers.

Aims of the Course:

To provide the education and practical training to enable the practitioner the skills to safely apply an appropriate cast/splint in the management of musculoskeletal disorders, injury or for immobilisation due to other medical conditions and to promote the best practice outcomes for patient care.

The course includes how to read X-ray's, discuss emergency management of fractures, review complications and management, discuss cast application - materials to use, type of cast required, practical demonstration and practice, practical application skills (Each participant must complete one supportive slab (volar or back slab), two full casts modifying one of these and remove both successfully utilising a range of casting materials) and assessments. The assessments will be conducted during and as part of the practical application skills session.

Course Delivery:

Total Hours of Learning - approx. 16 hours.

Hours include self directed learning and one (1) day of delivery including lecture, demonstration and practical workshop sessions prior to assessment taking place.
