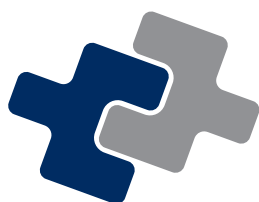

PROGRAM OUTLINE:

The Course in Immunisation Support in Primary Healthcare is designed to provide students (primary healthcare practice support staff) with the skills and knowledge to provide support in the delivery of a range of immunisation services in primary healthcare, to enhance patient care and to remain up-to-date with current vaccination programs, changes and requirements.

This course includes both online theory modules and a three-hour face-to-face workshop where students will practice skills including vaccine management and storage, data entry, and strategies to promote immunisation.

PROGRAM OUTCOME:

Upon successful completion of this program, students will be able to add to provide support in the delivery of a range of immunisation services in primary healthcare, to enhance patient care and to remain up-to-date with current vaccination programs, changes and requirements.

Increasing the workforce's capacity in this area will ultimately promote better immunisation rates within the community.

PROGRAM CONTENT:

The online component consists of learning modules and assessment. The content covered in the modules includes:

- Communicating immunisation information in primary healthcare
- Support systems and processes to deliver immunisation services
- Support immunisation needs for women in pregnancy
- Support immunisation needs to adults and older persons
- Support immunisation needs for school aged clients
- Support immunisation catch-up programs.

The face-to-face workshop involves students participating and practicing skills including vaccine management and storage, data entry and strategies for the promotion of immunisation.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE:

Course delivery and assessment for the Course in Immunisation Practice in Primary Healthcare includes Online learning and assessment completed via BenchmarqueIQ, and a three-hour face to face workshop.

To achieve competency in this course, students must demonstrate competency through realistic skills simulations and competently complete the online theory assessments covering essential knowledge and skills.
