Perform ECG

An electrocardiogram (ECG) is a medical test that detects cardiac (heart) abnormalities by measuring the electrical activity generated by the heart as it contracts. The machine that records the patient's ECG is called an electrocardiograph.

The electrocardiograph records the electrical activity of the heart muscle and displays this data as a trace on a screen or on paper.

ECGs from normal, healthy hearts have a characteristic shape. Any irregularity in the heart rhythm or damage to the heart muscle can change the electrical activity of the heart so that the shape of the ECG is changed.

An ECG may be requested for a patient experiencing symptoms such as chest pain, shortness of breath, dizziness, fainting, or fast or irregular heartbeats (palpitations). ECGs are often performed to monitor the health of patients who have been diagnosed with heart problems, to help assess artificial cardiac pacemakers or to monitor the effects of certain medications on the heart.

The standard 12-lead electrocardiogram is a representation of the heart's electrical activity recorded from 10 electrodes placed in standard positions on the body surface.

Course Outline

Perform electrocardiography (ECG) is a short course designed to develop the knowledge and skill required to perform an ECG correctly to allow for accurate interpretation.

On successful completion of this learning package, students will:

- Have an understanding of how the 12-lead ECG is produced
- Be able to prepare the ECG machine for use
- Be able to prepare the client to obtain an ECG
- Attach the ECG electrodes correctly
- Perform an ECG tracing
- Be able to recognise ECG rhythms that require urgent medical attention

It is especially relevant to practice nurses, pathology technicians, emergency nurses, and community, regional, rural and remote nurses.
