Unit outline

The Immunisation Endorsement Program is designed to provide knowledge to support authorised immunisers to administer a range of vaccines and competently manage any adverse reactions and side effects in the event no medical practitioner is present. Authorised immunisers work in a variety of settings including community, primary healthcare, tertiary and corporate organisations.

This unit forms part of the Immunisation Endorsement Pathway and students must complete the Foundations of Immunisation Practice Program and the Course in Immunisation Practice in Primary Healthcare (10754NAT) first.

Unit outcome

On completion of this unit the health professional will be able to:

- Understand the National, State or Territory Legislative Act relevant to immunisation practice within the jurisdiction they practice
- Apply fundamental elements of legislation, standards and codes for the administration of vaccines
- Demonstrate knowledge of state or territory legislation relating to authorisation/endorsement.

On successful completion students will receive a Certificate of Clinical Competency

Unit content

The Immunisation Endorsement Pathway recognises that registered nurses and registered midwives play an important role in maintaining high immunisation coverage rates through the provision of accurate and comprehensive information about vaccines and immunisation programs.

The unit provides students with comprehensive knowledge related to relevant legislation, standards and codes of practice for the administration of vaccines. This promotes consistency across states and territories among qualified health professionals involved in the implementation and application of immunisation procedures.

Unit structure

Delivery and assessment of this unit includes online learning completed via accessIQ.

To achieve clinical competency in this course, students must complete an assessment covering essential knowledge.

Unit entry requirements

Entrants to the Immunisation Endorsement Unit must provide evidence of a relevant professional role and hold the following:

- AHPRA registered nursing qualification
