Program outcome

On completion of this program the student will be able to:

- Identify and obtain clinical and personal relevant data for blood collection
- Choose the appropriate equipment for blood collection
- Perform the blood collection procedure
- Discuss the considerations that influence the correct selection of blood collection equipment including size and type of needle and collection site
- Perform post blood collection procedures including patient care, documentation and follow up
- Troubleshoot problems
- Discuss and manage possible complications.

Program content

The Perform Blood Collection Course will enable participants to enhance their ability to successfully perform venous blood collections using the evacuated system, winged infusion sets (butterfly needles), and the needle and syringe collection methods.

Program structure

To achieve competency in this program, students must successfully:

- Perform 10 blood collections in a simulated environment
- Complete an assessment covering essential knowledge and skills
- Complete 10 workplace observed blood collections of which 5 must be recorded and uploaded to be observed by a qualified assessor.

Workplace observed practice is a mandatory requirement for this course, workplace practice must be observed by a person currently working in a phlebotomist role for at least 18 hours per fortnight.

All workplace activities must be completed in accordance with work health and safety standards and all other relevant workplace policies and procedures.

The minimum cost for delivery is \$3900. A discount is available if you are able to provide venue hire for the event.

Please note, closed footwear is required for the workshop.
