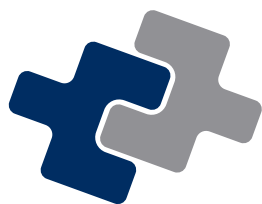

Course Summary	This program aims to educate healthcare providers on the changes to the National Cervical Screening Program and to promote the benefits of regular cervical screening to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander women.

During the half day face-to-face workshop, the following topics are covered:

- The National Cervical Screening Program
- Cervical cancer and cervical screening
- Promoting cervical screening to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander women
- Addressing client needs (communication strategies and effective techniques).

COURSE STRUCTURE:

Course delivery and assessment for Promoting Participation in the National Cervical Screening Program to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Women includes a half day face-to-face workshop and online assessment completed via BenchmarkIQ.

There is no pre-reading and all course materials are supplied. The online assessment activities do not need to be completed until after attendance at the half day workshop.
