<b>COURSE TITLE</b>	<b>Complex Catchups for Immunisation</b>
<b>VALUE FOR ORGANISATIONS</b>	An interactive virtual workshop for an experienced Immuniser in Australia, validating and expanding your clinical experiences are essential for your ongoing continued learning, and sharing these with other practitioners in a small classroom setting. Review catch-up principles and scenarios, and advance your learning by asking the questions you need from your clinical setting in a supportive environment. Discussing larger more complex catchup scenarios that may involve families and routine catchup schedules but with added complexity, such as country of origin.

<b>PRE-READING</b>	There is no pre-reading for this course. However there are documents to download and print in your resource library prior to your workshop.
<b>DELIVERY &amp; ASSESSMENT</b>	Virtual workshop. This workshop is delivered entirely online, utilising Zoom. It involves a face-to-face (virtual) workshop where students will practice catch-up scenarios and have an opportunity to ask questions and build scenarios they have seen in your practice. There are no formal assessment requirements for this course.
<b>ESTIMATED HOURS OF STUDY</b>	3 hours of active learning.
<b>CPD HOURS</b>	As a general guide, one (1) hour of active learning equates to one (1) hour of CPD. ## Course summary

You will review and refresh your knowledge on catch-ups using the Australian Immunisation Handbook Catch-Up Tables. We will then practice using complex catch-up scenario's. Using this time to ask questions and gain support to help you in your workplace.

## Course content

The session consists of blended learning in a small interactive virtual classroom, which includes Immunisation catch-ups, sharing of knowledge information, and self-reflection activities.

This course is designed for the more confident health professional with some experience in creating immunisation catch-up schedules

## Learning outcomes

By the end of this virtual workshop, you will have refreshed your knowledge on how to work through a more complex catch-up process and what needs to be considered. You will practice working through one or more scenario's using the Australian Immunisation Handbook Catch-Up Tables, and be provided with answers for questions you might have.
