Course summary

- Recognise the need to refer to a specialist
- Give the patient a comprehensive explanation of the examination findings
- Document the examination findings and outcome in the patient's history
- Perform a paediatric ear health assessment
- Accurately identify a range of conditions of the auditory system

- Apply a broad knowledge of strategies to manage a range of middle ear conditions
- Provide client-centred education to support health promotion
- Outline any follow-up required and make appropriate specialist referrals as needed.

You will feel confident performing otoscopy, tympanometry, and demonstrate the theoretical components of audiometric screening as well as gaining the ability to identify common ear health conditions.
