Course summary

The Hearing and Ear Health Foundations for Education Professionals course aims to provide students working within the education sector with knowledge and understanding of the key concepts of good hearing and ear health, and the ability to identify common conditions and issues that may occur in children aged 0-18 years.

This is a stand alone course and is recommended as a lead-in course to engage with as part of The Benchmark Group's Ear Health Learning Pathway.

The Hearing and Ear Health Foundations course for Education Professionals aims to provide students with the knowledge and understanding of the key concepts of good hearing and ear health, and the ability to identify conditions and issues that may occur in babies, children, and adolescents. The online-only course encompasses a wide range of interesting and engaging topics including the anatomy and physiology of the ear, hearing and hearing loss, good ear hygiene, and common ear conditions.

Students will also gain knowledge on the fundamentals of 'good' ear and hearing health in childhood and adolescence, understand basic ear health assessment principles, and identify common ear and hearing conditions and issues that may present.

Course outcome

Upon successful completion of the program students should have the ability to:

- Understand anatomy and physiology of the ear
- Understand the process of sound and hearing
- Understand the fundamentals of 'good' ear and hearing health throughout childhood and adolescence.
- Understand the impact of hearing loss

and how this can be identified, managed and prevented within the community.

- Understand basic ear health assessment principles
- Identify common ear and hearing conditions and issues that may present.

Course content

An online-only course consisting of blended learning including information, articles, learning videos and self-reflection activities. The course involves detailed information on anatomy and physiology, hearing through the lifespan, hearing loss, common conditions and good ear hygiene.

Entry Requirements

Entrants to the Hearing and Ear Health Foundations for Education Professionals are expected to be currently working within a relevant educational area or more than half way through their professional vocational, tafe or university training.. Relevant roles would include:

- Teachers
- Teachers Aids
- Child Care Workers
- Others on application.
